



## **Never Urgent Medication**

The following medication has been identified by our Doctors as non-urgent and can wait 48hrs for normal processing

<b>Any OTC Medication</b>	Ibuprofen, paracetamol, emollients, low dose co-codamol (8/500)
<b>Cholesterol</b>	Atorvastatin, simvastatin, ezetimibe
<b>Erectile Dysfunction</b>	Sildenafil (Viagra), tadalafil (Cialis)
<b>Osteoporosis</b>	Risedronate, alendronate
<b>Sleeping Tablets</b>	Zopiclone, Melatonin, Zolpidem
<b>Thyroid</b>	Levothyroxine
<b>Skin creams</b>	
<b>Nutrition supplements</b>	
<b>Vitamins</b>	Folic acid, B12, Vitamin D, Iron, Forceval, calcium

<b>ADHD</b>	Methylphenidate (Concerta, Medikinet), lisdexamfetamine
<b>Anaphylaxis</b>	Epipen, Jext, Emirade
<b>Asthma/COPD</b>	Inhalers/nebulisers, Salbutamol
<b>Contraception</b>	1 month ONLY
<b>Diabetes</b>	Insulin, metformin, gliclazide
<b>Epilepsy</b>	Lamotrigine, levetiracetam (Keppra), Phenytoin
<b>Eye drops</b>	
<b>Heart</b>	GTN spray, digoxin
<b>Heart Failure</b>	Furosemide, bumetanide, metolazone, eplerenone
<b>Anticoagulants</b>	Warfarin, rivaroxaban, dabigatran, apixaban
<b>End of life medication</b>	
<b>Painkillers</b>	NOT ones available OTC
<b>Antidepressants</b>	Sertraline, citalopram, fluoxetine, mirtazapine, duloxetine
<b>Other mental health</b>	Quetiapine (Seroquel, Zaluron), Olanzapine, Risperidone
<b>Steroid (tablets)</b>	Prednisolone, hydrocortisone
<b>Parkinson's</b>	Ropinerole, Levodopa (co-beneldopa, co-careldopa), pramipexole
